**Comments:**

- Providers include physicians and non-physicians. (See tables.)
- # Rx includes initial prescription and refills.
- See other tables for all oxymorphone (brand + generic) and all opioid narcotics.

Note wide variation in Rx per provider and relatively large number of total prescriptions in a few smaller cities.
